### Jesus Casts Out an Unclean Spirit

<sup>21</sup> Then they went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and taught. <sup>22</sup> And they were astonished at His teaching, for He taught them as one having **authority**, and not as the scribes. <sup>23</sup> Now there was a man in their synagogue with an unclean spirit. And he cried out, <sup>24</sup> saying, "Let us alone! What have we to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Did You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God!" <sup>25</sup> But Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be quiet, and come out of him!" <sup>26</sup> And when the unclean spirit had convulsed him and cried out with a loud voice, he came out of him. <sup>27</sup> Then they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, "What is this? What new doctrine is this? For with **authority** He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him." <sup>28</sup> And immediately His fame spread throughout all the region around Galilee. **Peter's Mother-in-Law Healed.** <sup>29</sup> Now as soon as they had come out of the synagogue, they entered the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. <sup>30</sup> But Simon's wife's mother lay sick with a fever, and they told Him about her at once. <sup>31</sup> So **He came and took her by the hand and lifted her up**, and immediately the fever left her. And she served them.

**Many Healed After Sabbath Sunset** <sup>32</sup> At evening, when the sun had set, they brought to Him all who were sick and those who were demon-possessed. <sup>33</sup> *And the whole city was gathered together at the door.* <sup>34</sup> Then **He healed many** who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him. **Preaching in Galilee.** <sup>35</sup> Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, **He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.** <sup>36</sup> And Simon and those *who were with Him* searched for Him. <sup>37</sup> When they found Him, they said to Him, "Everyone is looking for You." <sup>38</sup> But He said to them, "Let us go into the next towns, that I may preach there also, because for this purpose I have come forth."

<sup>39</sup> And He was preaching in their synagogues throughout all Galilee, and casting out demons.
