¹³ Now the Passover of the Jews was at hand, and Jesus
went up to Jerusalem. ¹⁴ And He found in the temple
those who sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the
money changers doing business. ¹⁵ When He had made
a whip of cords, He drove them all out of the temple,
with the sheep and the oxen, and poured out the
changers’ money and overturned the tables. ¹⁶ And He
said to those who sold doves, **“Take these things away!
Do not make My Father’s house a house of
merchandise!”** ¹⁷ Then His disciples remembered that it
was written, “Zeal for Your house has eaten Me up.” ¹⁸ So
the Jews answered and said to Him, “What sign do You
show to us, since You do these things?” ¹⁹ Jesus
answered and said to them, **“Destroy this temple, and in
three days I will raise it up.”** ²⁰ Then the Jews said, “It has
taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will You
raise it up in three days?” ²¹ But He was speaking of the
temple of His body. ²² Therefore, when He had risen
from the dead, His disciples remembered that He had
said this to them; and they believed the Scripture and
the word which Jesus had said.”
